




Perception of Safety - 61% of respondents indicated that they felt mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. 56% of respondents considered a local area unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (46%) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". 73% of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months, indicating expanded community perspective access.


The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes and specific issues and locations. Homelessness was identified as the primary concern citywide (142 Respondents).
