




Perception of Safety - 62% of respondents indicated that they felt | The feed provides open text comments identifying general themes mostly or completely safe in their neighborhood. 53% of respondents considered a local area unsafe. The most frequent reason given for this perception (47%) was because they "Personally witnessed or been a victim of crime". 74% of respondents reported not being victims of crime in the past 6 months, indicating expanded community perspective access.


